

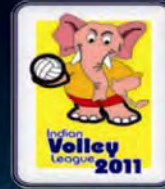

Raging Bulls lose again

Karnataka outfit suffers its third-straight loss; Tigers beat Killers

BANGALORE: An air of confidence hung over the Karnataka Bulls' camp as they went about their warm-up, prior to their Indian Volley League match against Hyderabad Chargers, with renewed vigor, and they sure did put it good use during the memorable encounter, but a win to get their campaign rolling eluded them yet again.

On a thrilling Tuesday, which saw fortunes swing back and forth with every serve, the Bulls succumbed to a 27-29, 28-30, 25-23, 16-25 loss at the hands of the men from Hyderabad, but they had every reason to hold their head up high and hope for things to brighten-up in the course of the month-long tournament.

For starters, the Bulls looked a more composed lot on the blocking front and secondly, they went about their business with a sense of purpose – something they didn't seem to have in their previous two games. However, the improvement meant little to the dwindling, boisterous crowd as the result painted a different picture.

In the opening set, the Bulls got off to a promising start, but the Chargers caught up with them and levelled scores at 4-4. Spikers Lalit Kumar and Lavneet Katariya gave Chargers the sting they required to take the lead at 5-4 and hold on to it for the most part but the Bulls were never too far behind. Despite managing to score some points, Sanjay Ku-

mar was off the mark with his powerless smashes but blockers Jagadeesh and N Shelton Moses did justice to their role in style to even the score at 20-20.

With the crowd behind egging them on, the Bulls looked set to clinch the first set, however, the Chargers, who looked unmoved by the situation, held their nerve and grabbed the set.

Both the teams were engaged in a heady battle at the start of the second set and with neither willing to let go of an inch, the battle waged on. The lead switched hands on several occasions but it was the Chargers who came on top in the end as the Bulls' tendency to lose their calm in pressure situations was on display again.

Coach Om Prakash swapped the injured Sanjay, who hurt his back at the start of the second set, with Anup D' Costa in the third set and the Bulls suddenly looked primed to stage a thrilling come back. With local lad Anup spiking from the back court, A Vikram, who has been in good touch, found some space on the front and the duo made the most of Chargers' fragile blocking unit to reduce the deficit to 1-2.

However, Chargers skipper M Ukkara Pandiyam synchronised his sides' every move to perfection and the outcome of that was another Bulls defeat in the fourth set.

Chargers tame Bulls

Home team suffers three losses on the trot; Chennai Spikers outshine Maratha Warriors

Karnataka Bulls just don't seem to find their winning mantra. Despite staying on top of the game for the better part of nearly two hours against Hyderabad Chargers, the hosts failed to pull off that magical touch in crunch situations, resulting in their third loss on the trot. The Bulls allowed Chargers to register their second win in the inaugural edition of the Indian Volley League on Tuesday.

The Utkra Pandiyan-led side rode on the mistakes made by Bulls to clinch a 3-1 (25-27 30-28 23-25 25-16) win in front of a rather bullish crowd at the Sri Kanteerava Indoor Stadium.

Going by the way they started the league, Bulls undoubtedly looked like the better unit against Chargers compared to their previous two matches, where they lost 0-3 to Yanam Tigers and 1-3 to Chennai Spikers.

A crucial substitution in the second set where coach MH Kumara brought in VR Sanoj in place of S Karthik, dented Bulls hopes. At this point, Karnataka were ahead of Chargers by two points (19-9).

But an outstanding pass by setter Deposh K Sinha to skipper Pandiyan helped them earn a point while Bulls Captain Ravikumar's net touch while trying to spike the ball brought the Chargers back into contention.

Though Ravi made amends with his serve in the next rally, Sanoj was impeccably on top of his game and that helped Chargers have a control over the game.

Universal Sanjay Kumar, however, continued to lead a spirited fight-back by the Bulls which kept the

scorecard evenly poised at 27-27 with Chargers, a silly error by Bulls blockers saw Chargers through.

Before the third set could start, Bulls suffered a major setback as Sanjay sat out of the game with a niggle in his knee.

However, the Bulls fought back through local all-rounder Anup D'Costa's brilliance in the third set and ran up a three-point lead (04-03) at the start of the set. Bulls were right on top of their game with accurate passes that worked much better, while their blocking and smashes were a revelation. Shelton Moses, Vikram and Jagadeesh came up



with crucial winners at the net to keep the Chargers at bay. Bulls won the set 25-23, thus giving hopes to the crowds that erupted in jubilation.

Sadly though, with the end in sight, the Bulls lost the script. Hyderabad blocker Lavmeet Katariya, and Sanoj, came up with great blocks off Anup and Vikram, who was solid right through, but failed with their spike at that juncture. Ravi and Moses followed suit to let Chargers take clinch set and the game.

Warriors lose to Chennai Spikers

Earlier in the day, Maratha Warriors

were outplayed by the fancied Chennai Spikers with a crushing 3-0 victory, their second straight win in the six-team league.

Riding high on their win against Yanam Tigers, Maratha Warriors were expected to come through with ease. Unfortunately for them, their form players - Selva Prabhu, Omvic Mann failed to live up to the expectation. That suited the Spikers just fine as they capitalized and won 25-22 25-13 25-18.

Karnataka Bulls Suffer 3rd Defeat

Bangalore: Karnataka Bulls' efforts to remove the losers tag, yet again suffered a blow as they went down fighting to Hyderabad Chargers 27-29, 28-30, 25-23, 16-25 in a closely fought Indian Volley League at the Sri Kanteerava Stadium on Tuesday. The Bulls did match their rivals in all departments but a back spasm to their key attacker Sanjay Sharma, who was rested from the third set, cost the Bulls dearly.

The intensity between the teams was high as it was ap-

parent from the fact that two of the Bulls players – Skipper TD Ravi Kumar and libero Darshan – entered the bad books for challenging referee Vinod Nair and second referee in the fourth set. In the process, Chargers were benefited with two bonus points.

After losing the first two sets, the Bulls came back strongly in the third sparking hopes of victory. But the Bulls committed too many mistakes for the Chargers to cash in.

Chennai Spikers, with an all-round show, halted Maratha Warriors' winning

spree with a convincing 25-22, 25-13, 25-18 victory. Having won a game and lost one, the Chennai Spikers went about their job with methodic precision. They excelled in all departments giving no chance whatsoever for the high-flying Warriors to come into the game. The match lasted a little over 54 minutes.

The Spikers' coach A Venkateshan justified the decision to rest veteran skipper Nadarajan and handing over the responsibility to his young brigade. Of course, the Chennai team was superbly guided by the experienced and former

India skipper KJ Kapil Dev. The Warriors, who tasted their first defeat after two successive wins, had no answers for Chennai's powerful smashes and their own attack failed miserably.

Though Spikers' Prabhakaran was offcolour with his serves compensated with his deadly smashes close to the net. Ragesh was also at his spiking best. The defence manned by Mandeep Singh was equally brilliant.

Earlier, Yanam Tigers snatched their second win in three games with a smooth 25-17, 25-19, 25-25 win over Kerala Killers.

Kapil dazzles as Chennai spike Warriors

Bangalore: Having enjoyed a free ride by the hosts on Monday evening, Chennai Spikers proved they can win without any help from their rivals with a brilliant all-round show on the third day of the inaugural Indian Volley League here.

At the Sri Kanteerva Indoor Stadium on Tuesday, long before the evening crowd could troop in, Chennai scored

an annihilating 3-0 win over the hitherto undefeated Maharashtra Warriors. The 60-minute victory, their second in three matches, also kept their hopes of winning the firm's leg alive.

Setter Kapil Dev was the architect of Chennai's splendid win. His handling of the match was spot on, using the resources at hand with aplomb. Attacker Prabhakaran, who was patchy against the Bulls on Monday, came into his own with thundering winners, more so from the backcourt.

Prabhakaran, Mandeep and the left-handed Ragesh, besides their kills, gave the Warriors defence a torrid time with their power-packed jump serves. With the Warriors' first pass in total disarray, there was nothing much their setter Balwinder Singh, nor his replacement Anil Kumar Edella, could do as Chennai wrapped up the match without breaking into a sweat.

Chargers outclass Bulls

Later in the day, it was Hyderabad Chargers' turn to hand Karnataka Bulls — who are performing like the way the Royal Challengers Bangalore did in the inaugural edition of IPL — a 3-1 defeat on Tuesday. Chargers, who suffered a melt-down against Kerala Killers on Monday, topped their game against a charged up Bulls in a match that could have gone either way. Chargers did just about enough to clinch the first two sets.

In the third, despite their key player, Sanjay Kumar, sitting out with a back injury he sustained in the second set

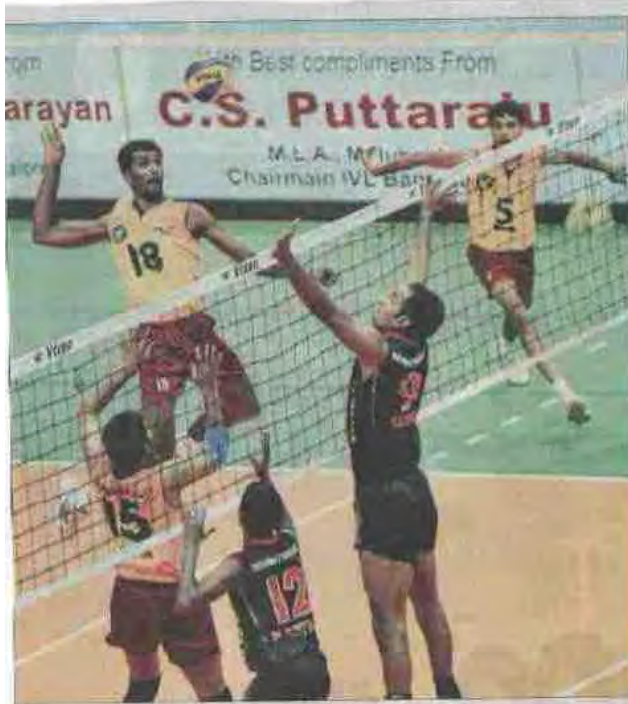
while going for a kill, Bulls came roaring back to pull one back. Anup D'Costa, who came in for Sanjay, played his heart out, and Vikram topped his game a notch to help Bulls take the third set.

However, the Bulls' joy was short-lived as Chargers tightened their blocks against a team that was questioning the referee's calls constantly. Vinod Nair from Chhattisgarh even flailed the yellow card twice during the fourth set that Chargers won with plenty to spare.

There was more drama off the court when Bulls coach Om Prakash and Nair resorted to lip service. Attacker Sanjay, who is unlikely to play the next two matches, too joined in. Fortunately, before things could get out of hand, the organizers stepped in to ease the tension.
