

# Games Technical Conduct Committee (GTCC)

MEETING (Monday, November 10, 2014)



The Games Technical Conduct Committee (GTCC), which comprises representatives of Indian Olympic Association and all National Sports Federations (NSFs), reviewed the arrangements at all venues during its recent visit to Kerala. The Committee was given the assurance by NGOC that construction works would be completed at all sites by 31st December 2014 and that all equipments would be available at the venues latest by 1st week of January 2015.

Meetings of the GTCC under the chairmanship of K Murugan were held on 6th, 7th & 8th November at Kozhikode, Ernakulam and Thiruvananthapuram respectively. S. M Bali, Chairman, IOA Co-ordination Committee and Rakesh Gupta, Joint Secretary, IOA, were also present.

There was agreement at the GTCC that cut off dates of qualifying events be kept as 20th November 2014 and all NSFs are to provide relevant data of qualified teams, participants and the daily schedule of their events by that date. NGOC announced its readiness for online accreditation of athletes, team officials & technical officials.

The Secretaries of the Federations, Directors of Competition, Competition Managers & State Association Secretaries of 31 sports also visited venues that will host their respective disciplines.
