Age-Proof

The following decision with regard to age verification was taken.

Original Secondary School Certificate or Corporation/Municipality Birth Certificate duly counter-signed by the State Association concerned or Passport or Certificate from the Hospitals approved by Sports Authority of India are the valid Documents for Age proof.

They should be made available and the Scrutinizing Committee will have a Doctor from the Federation to verify the bonafide of the players concerned.
